Background of the Turnaround Achievement Award: "Forever it seems, students have deservingly been awarded for academic, athletic, and artistic achievement. Now we are recognizing students who have struggled to turn their

lives around. In the past twenty-eight years, students have been honored with an evening to mark their special accomplishments. The program reflects marked improvement in personal behavior, attitude, and academics. It demonstrates that there are students with serious educational and personal challenges who alter their future by changing their attitude.

1,045 students have been honoured in Districts 17 and 18 (now known as Anglophone West School District) over the past twenty-eight years and \$520,000 in scholarship money has been awarded.
